## BREKKY BOY

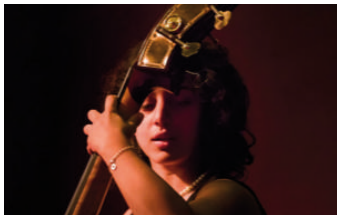

Frank is a storyteller in the traditional sense, inspired by the greats like Ray Charles and Bob Dylan. His songs are in one breath sad, dark, joyous and hopeful. Awash with vintage guitar tones, he has a truly unique and raw soulful voice. See him solo or with his band of musical hooligans, The Sinister Kids. (Or see both.)



## GROOVE ORGANISM

A Sydney-based organ trio recreating the spirit of the 1960s Blue Note era. The trio follows the traditional organ trio line up with Matt Russell on guitar, John Tweed on organ and Alex Masso on drums.



## JARROD SHAW



Jarrod Shaw possesses a passion and appreciation for blues music that becomes obvious from the moment the first note sounds. He delivers a soulful blues inspired show, with a unique guitar approach and musical style of his own.



## JAZZ DAIQUIRI

A cool lounge jazz trio based in the Blue Mountains, featuring Robyn Gordon on vocals, Karl Javernig on guitar and Martyn Cook on clarinet, trumpet, saxophones and flute. Their sound is a mix of jazz classics and originals.





## JESSE VALACH



Melbourne's fiery blues/soul singer-songwriter Jesse Valach combines intense guitar and soulful vocals. He will take you on a journey from lights down low soul ballads to energetic shuffle romps, all delivered in demanding fashion.

This exciting young Canberran is a talented singer-songwriter with a relaxed story-telling vocal style that partners well with his acoustic guitar. His unique sound will stay with you.

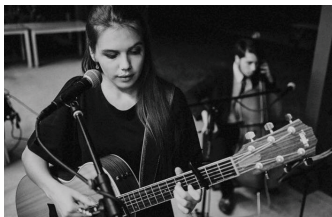
## LIZA OHLBACK & THE MERCY TRAIN

An electric and original take on the Delta Blues. Lead singer Milan's striking baritone vocals evoke the spirit of a great poet. His guitar playing is the sound of a simple, primitive and hypnotic blues boogie - one that sounds as though it was developed at the dawn of time.

Nyssa and Alex are a brother/sis acoustic duo from Bowral NSW. They bring a chilled and relaxed style with the combination of guitar, cello and clear melodies providing a unique sound.
